

Using 'Higher Dictation' – Pupil Help Sheet

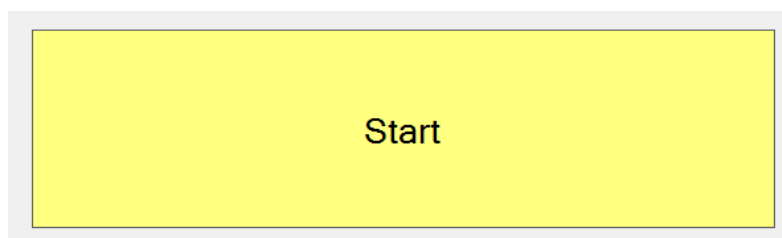
1. Follow the instructions in the **Accessing Speedy Readers** Help Sheet
2. Select **Higher Dictation** from the home screen



3. Choose a **text** from the list



4. Make sure you've got a pencil and paper (or your Speedy Readers jotter) then click **Start**



5. Listen carefully to each part that is read out and write it down:

- Click **Say again** if you want to hear the section again – you can use the words from the **Spelling Helper** to help you
- Click **Next Phrase** when you have written the section
