Please find below the November Update from the Highland Emerging Literacy Working Group.

#### P1 Bookbug Pack

Many schools engaged with the Highland Library Service through their 'P1 Bookbug Family Pack' training towards the end of October/ early November. It's great to hear that many schools have arranged to work with the Highland Library Service this week (Book Week Scotland) to support the gifting of the P1 Bookbug Pack. Working in partnership with the Library Service is a great way to instil a love of reading.

## **Emerging Literacy Training**

We delivered another 'Emerging Literacy' session after the October holidays in Inverness. We have now trained 80% of staff working with Primary 1 children across the Authority. The Emerging Literacy Working Group are in the process of organising further training events in the Fort William and Thurso areas – more details will follow.

#### **Developmental Continua**

The Emerging Literacy Group have been further developing the <u>Developmental Continua</u> which underpin Emerging Literacy. They have been reviewing the Phonological Awareness, Pre-Handwriting, Concepts of Print and Oral Language materials with P1 practitioners. After the Christmas break there will be materials to supplement the <u>Phonological Awareness Continuum</u> published on the Highland Literacy Blog in August 2015.
