



Read, Write, Count aims to improve the literacy and numeracy skills of Scotland's children by providing advice and support for the families of children in Primary 1, 2 and 3. It is a key driver of the Scottish Government's commitment to raise attainment for all and close the attainment gap through the driver of family learning.
