February and March – Network 4 Content

The fourth round of networks in February and March explored the:

- [Using Texts to Play and Talk Together](#) guidance to support play and exploration. This looked at developing play contexts linked to a text, focusing on the adult's role through observation and playing and talking together, and support children to review their play.
- 'What makes an Early Level reader and writer?' – Using the Early Level Literacy and English Progression, practitioners reflected on the skills developed in early reading and writing, using the progression to support moderation.
