



Bookbug (P1) and Read, Write, Count (P2 and P3) aims to improve the literacy and numeracy skills of Scotland's children by providing advice and support for the families of children in Primary 1, 2 and 3. It is a key driver of the Scottish Government's commitment to raise attainment for all and close the attainment gap through the driver of family learning.

As part of the Bookbug (P1) and Read, Write, Count (P2 and P3) campaigns, children across Scotland will receive a book bag. The packs will arrive in schools between October and November. Children in Gaelic Medium will receive an English and a Gaelic pack.
